- <u>EFFECT:</u> (1) Requires, rather than encourages, a public utility district and port district to make specified findings and report to its governing body before providing retail telecommunications services.
- (2) Requires a public utility district and port district to also report specified findings to the Statewide Broadband Office.
- (3) Adds report requirements regarding sources of funding for the project that will supplement any grant or loan program, and a strategic plan to maintain long-term operation of the infrastructure, and the expected installation charges and monthly costs for end users.
- (4) Requires the Statewide Broadband Office to post a review of the proposed project on its website.
- (5) Provides that the review may include an assessment of the project's economic and technical feasibility as conducted by the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission.
- (6) Removes the report requirement regarding evidence relating to the underserved nature of the community in which retail telecommunications services will be provided.
