1 Beginning on page 200, line 22, strike all of section 3322 and
2 insert the following:

3 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 3322. FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL
4 RESOURCES

5 DNR and Camp Colman Collaboration (92000037)

6 The appropriation in this section is subject to the following
7 conditions and limitations:

8 (1) \$100,000 of the appropriation in this section is provided
9 solely for the department to contract with a third party facilitator
10 for the purpose of collaborating with the YMCA of Greater Seattle,
11 Camp Colman, on finding solutions for maintaining a high-quality camp
12 experience and establishing a barrier free passage for migrating fish
13 species at Whiteman cove. Should the department and the YMCA reach
14 agreement about a collaborative process, the department must report
15 to the fiscal committees of the legislature by December 1, 2021,
16 about areas of mutual agreement and any recommendations that could be
17 enacted by the legislature. If the department and the YMCA of Greater
18 Seattle choose to not begin to collaborate by July 31, 2021, the
19 funding in this subsection (1) shall lapse.

20 (2) \$300,000 of the appropriation in this section must be held in
21 unallotted status by the office of financial management if the
22 department and the YMCA of Greater Seattle choose to collaborate. If
23 the department and the YMCA of Greater Seattle parties choose to not
24 collaborate by July 31, 2021, then the office of financial management
25 must allot the \$300,000 provided in this subsection (2) to the
26 department to proceed with the design of the fish blockage removal
27 project at Whiteman cove.

EFFECT: Provides funding for the Department of Natural Resources to conduct the design of a fish blockage removal project if the department and the YMCA of Greater Seattle choose to not collaborate on finding mutually beneficial solutions.

FISCAL IMPACT: Increases by \$300,000 the GF-S appropriation.
