The department of transportation 10 11 must submit progress reports on its efforts to reduce the toxicity of 12 stormwater runoff from existing infrastructure, recommendations for 13 addressing barriers to innovative solutions, and anticipated demand 14 for funding each biennium."

EFFECT: States legislative intent that \$500,000,000 of the amounts identified for Preservation & Maintenance on LEAP Transportation Document 2022-B as developed February 14, 2022, must enhance stormwater runoff treatment from existing roads and infrastructure with an emphasis on green infrastructure retrofits. Projects must be prioritized based on benefits to salmon recovery and ecosystem health, reducing toxic pollution, addressing health disparities, and cost-effectiveness. The department of transportation must submit progress reports on its efforts to reduce the toxicity of stormwater runoff from existing infrastructure, recommendations for addressing barriers to innovative solutions, and anticipated demand for funding each biennium.
