Synopsis as Enacted

Brief Description: Making transportation appropriations for the 2021-2023 fiscal biennium.

Sponsors: Senate Committee on Transportation (originally sponsored by Senators Hobbs, King, Nobles, Saldaña and Wilson, C.; by request of Office of Financial Management).

Senate Committee on Transportation

Background: The operating and capital expenses of state transportation agencies and programs are funded on a biennial basis by an omnibus transportation budget adopted by the Legislature in odd-numbered years. Additionally, supplemental budgets may be adopted during the biennium, making various modifications to agency appropriations.

Summary: Appropriations are provided for certain state transportation agencies and programs for the 2021-23 fiscal biennium and are adjusted for the 2019-2021 biennium. Various appropriations and provisos are modified.
