- AN ACT Relating to declaratory and other relief in actions to determine the validity of certain gubernatorial orders; amending RCW 7.24.020 and 7.24.100; adding a new section to chapter 7.24 RCW;
- 4 creating a new section; and declaring an emergency.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 6 **Sec. 1.** RCW 7.24.020 and 1935 c 113 s 2 are each amended to read as follows:
 - (1) A person interested under a deed, will, written contract or other writings constituting a contract, or whose rights, status or other legal relations are affected by a statute, order issued by the governor pursuant to chapter 43.06 RCW, municipal ordinance, contract or franchise, may have determined any question of construction or validity arising under the instrument, statute, order, ordinance, contract or franchise and obtain a declaration of rights, status or other legal relations thereunder.
- 16 (2) For purposes of determining the validity of an order issued
 17 by the governor pursuant to chapter 43.06 RCW, where the order at
 18 issue has not been or will not be enforced, an issue of continuing
 19 and substantial public interest exists and is likely to recur, and
 20 the final authoritative determination of the issue is essential.

NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 7.24 RCW to read as follows:

Where an order issued by the governor pursuant to chapter 43.06
RCW is determined to be invalid in whole or in relevant part, the
court shall enjoin enforcement of the order or part of the order
determined to be invalid and award actual damages to the prevailing
plaintiff. The court may, in its discretion, increase the award of
damages to an amount not more than three times the actual damages
sustained.

- 10 **Sec. 3.** RCW 7.24.100 and 1935 c 113 s 10 are each amended to 11 read as follows:
- 12 $((\frac{\exists n}{}))$ (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section, 13 <u>in</u> any proceeding under this chapter, the court may make such award 14 of costs as may seem equitable and just.
- (2) Where an order issued by the governor pursuant to chapter
 43.06 RCW is determined to be invalid in whole or in relevant part,
 the court shall award reasonable attorneys' fees and costs to the
 prevailing plaintiff.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 4. This act applies to all causes of action commenced on or after the effective date of this section, regardless of when the cause of action arose. To this extent, this act applies retroactively, but in all other respects it applies prospectively.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 5. This act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the state government and its existing public institutions, and takes effect immediately.
