1 AN ACT Relating to modifying the offense of disorderly conduct;
2 and amending RCW 9A.84.030.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 9A.84.030 and 2007 c 2 s 1 are each amended to read
5 as follows:

6 (1) A person is guilty of disorderly conduct if the person:

7 (a) Uses abusive language and thereby intentionally creates a
8 risk of assault;

9 (b) Intentionally disrupts any lawful assembly or meeting of
10 persons without lawful authority;

11 (c) Intentionally obstructs vehicular or pedestrian traffic
12 without lawful authority; ((~~or~~))

13 (d)(i) Intentionally engages in fighting or in tumultuous conduct
14 or makes unreasonable noise, within five hundred feet of:

15 (A) The location where a funeral or burial is being performed;

16 (B) A funeral home during the viewing of a deceased person;

17 (C) A funeral procession, if the person described in this
18 subsection (1)(d) knows that the funeral procession is taking place;
19 or

20 (D) A building in which a funeral or memorial service is being
21 conducted; and

1 (ii) Knows that the activity adversely affects the funeral,
2 burial, viewing, funeral procession, or memorial service; or

3 (e) Uses abusive language towards a peace officer or insults or
4 taunts a peace officer with offensive or derisive words in a manner
5 that would alarm a reasonable and prudent peace officer or place him
6 or her in reasonable fear of his or her safety or the safety of
7 others.

8 (2) Disorderly conduct is a misdemeanor.
