- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- The legislature finds that the federal 4 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. court injunction in U.S. v. Washington directs the state to correct 5 6 culverts under state maintained roads that hinder fish passage and 7 create barriers for fish to swim upstream by 2030. The court order imposed environmental justice obligations to correct adverse impacts. 8 The legislature finds the court order addresses the same issues that 9 are sought to be addressed by chapter 314, Laws of 2021. Further 10 11 review of projects only delay the correction of the adverse impacts 12 and are counterproductive to the improved outcomes being sought. For
