- AN ACT Relating to data reporting requirements for hospitals; adding a new section to chapter 70.41 RCW; adding a new section to chapter 71.12 RCW; creating a new section; and declaring an

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 6 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. The legislature finds that state data 7 reporting requirements for hospitals are placing unwarranted burdens on the health care system during the national and state emergency 8 related to the COVID-19 pandemic. Further, the legislature finds that 9 10 a moratorium on state agencies imposing new data and information 11 reporting obligations on hospitals, other than reporting necessary 12 for COVID-19 pandemic patient care and vaccinations, is necessary to allow an assessment of current hospital reporting obligations. The 13 legislature further finds that such an assessment must identify which 14 15 hospital data reporting obligations need to be modified and whether 16 collecting additional data or information fulfills legislative 17 objectives.
- 18 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 70.41
- 19 RCW to read as follows:

1 Until December 31, 2022, or the end of the state of emergency related to the COVID-19 pandemic, whichever is later, the department, 2 the health care authority, or any other state agency may not 3 establish by rule or otherwise any new requirement for a hospital 4 licensed under this chapter to report data or information except as 5 6 specifically provided in this section. This limitation on establishing new data and information reporting requirements includes 7 data or information related to the health care cost transparency 8 board under chapter 70.390 RCW. The department may establish new data 9 information reporting requirements reasonably necessary to 10 11 address the COVID-19 pandemic for patient care and vaccines. Nothing 12 in this section changes the applicability of existing rules regarding hospitals licensed under this chapter reporting data and information 13 14 to the department, the health care authority, and any other state agencies. 15

NEW SECTION. Sec. 4. This act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the state government and its existing public institutions, and takes effect immediately.
