- 1 AN ACT Relating to prohibiting traffic stops for certain traffic
- 2 violations; and adding a new section to chapter 46.64 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 46.64 5 RCW to read as follows:
- 6 (1) A law enforcement officer may not stop, or otherwise detain, 7 a driver of a motor vehicle to enforce the following violations:
- 8 (a) Failure to keep to the right, as defined by RCW 46.61.100 or 46.61.105;
- 10 (b) Improper turn, as defined by RCW 46.61.290;
- 11 (c) Failure to stop, as defined by RCW 46.61.055, 46.61.065,
- 12 46.61.195, 46.61.200, 46.61.340, 46.61.345, 46.61.350, 46.61.365,
- 13 46.61.370, or 46.61.375;
- 14 (d) Failure to dim lights, as defined by RCW 46.37.230, and any
- 15 other equipment violation under chapter 46.37 RCW not defined as a
- 16 moving violation under WAC 308-104-160;
- 17 (e) Parking violations under chapter 46.61 RCW;
- 18 (f) Driving without a license under RCW 46.20.015;
- 19 (g) Vehicle registration violation under RCW 46.16A.030 (4) and

1 (h) Failure to maintain proof of motor vehicle insurance under 2 RCW 46.30.020; and

- (i) The following violations suspected solely on the basis of the odor of marijuana: (i) Driving under the influence under RCW 46.61.502; (ii) driver under twenty-one consuming alcohol or marijuana under RCW 46.61.503; and (iii) physical control of a motor vehicle under the influence under RCW 46.61.504.
- (2) Enforcement of the violations listed in subsection (1) of this section may be accomplished only as a secondary action when a driver of a motor vehicle has been detained for a suspected moving violation defined under WAC 308-104-160 not listed in this section.
