- AN ACT Relating to offender management network information and electronic health records systems at the department of corrections; adding a new section to chapter 72.09 RCW; and creating a new section.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 72.09
 RCW to read as follows:
- 8 (1)(a) The department shall replace the offender management 9 network information system at the department with a more efficient 10 and technologically advanced system.
- 11 (b) The department shall use a competitive request for a proposal 12 process to replace the offender management network information system 13 under this section.
- 14 (c) The department shall leverage existing resources, development plans, and funding.
- 16 (2)(a) The department shall implement a comprehensive electronic 17 health records system at the department.
- 18 (b) The comprehensive electronic health records system 19 implemented by the department shall be able to communicate with 20 information and data systems used by managed care organizations for 21 purposes of care coordination activities.
