SENATE BILL 5908

State of Washington 67th Legislature 2022 Regular Session

Read first time 01/19/22. Referred to Committee on State Government & Elections.

- AN ACT Relating to creating the clean car authority as a new state government agency; adding a new section to chapter 41.06 RCW;
- 3 and adding a new chapter to Title 43 RCW.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 Sec. 1. (1) There is hereby created a clean car NEW SECTION. 6 authority. The purpose of the authority is to distribute electric 7 vehicle grant funding awarded to Washington state from the federal infrastructure investment and jobs act, P.L. 117-58. Additionally, 8 the authority shall provide a general vision for the state regarding 9 10 the most beneficial and efficient distribution of electric vehicle 11 grants, as well as coordinate and oversee the administration of 12 electric vehicle grants across all state agencies and local governments. The authority shall also coordinate its efforts with the 13 14 office of climate commitment accountability, if in existence.
 - (2) Pursuant to RCW 70A.02.030, the clean car authority shall assume all of the substantive and procedural requirements of covered agencies under chapter 70A.02 RCW (environmental justice) by notifying the environmental justice council established in RCW 70A.02.110.

- 1 (3) The authority is vested with all powers and duties delegated 2 to it under this chapter and such other powers and duties as may be 3 authorized by law.
- 4 (4) The authority may adopt rules under chapter 34.05 RCW as may 5 be necessary to carry out the powers and duties delegated to it.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. The definitions in this section apply throughout this chapter unless the context clearly requires otherwise.
 - (1) "Authority" means the clean car authority.

- 10 (2) "Director" means the director of the clean car authority.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. The executive head and appointing 11 12 authority of the authority is the director. The director shall be appointed by the governor, with the consent of the senate, and serves 13 14 at the pleasure of the governor. The director shall be paid a salary 15 to be fixed by the governor in accordance with RCW 43.03.040. If a vacancy occurs in the position while the senate is not in session, 16 17 the governor shall make a temporary appointment until the next 18 meeting of the senate.
- 19 NEW SECTION. Sec. 4. (1) The internal affairs of the authority 20 shall be under the control of the director. Whenever the director's authority is not specifically limited by law, the director has 21 22 complete charge and supervisory powers over the authority. The director may create such administrative structures as the director 23 considers appropriate, except as otherwise specified by law. The 24 25 director may employ such personnel as necessary for the general administration of the authority. This employment shall be in 26 accordance with the state civil service law, chapter 41.06 RCW, 27 28 except as otherwise provided.
- 29 (2) Any power or duty vested in or transferred to the director by 30 law or executive order may be delegated by the director to a deputy 31 director or to any other assistant or subordinate, but the director 32 is responsible for the official acts of the officers and employees of 33 the authority.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 5. The director shall appoint an industry advisory committee to provide recommendations to the director regarding the function of the authority. The industry advisory

- 1 committee shall include representation from the electric vehicle
- 2 industry, interested stakeholders, and applicable state and local
- 3 agencies tasked with administering electric vehicle grants. The
- 4 industry advisory committee shall be constituted as the director may
- 5 determine. Members of the industry advisory committee may be paid
- 6 their travel expenses in accordance with RCW 43.03.050 and 43.03.060.
- 7 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 6.** A new section is added to chapter 41.06
- 8 RCW to read as follows:
- 9 In addition to the exemptions under RCW 41.06.070, this chapter
- 10 does not apply to the director, and to the deputy director should one
- 11 be appointed, of the clean car authority established under chapter
- 12 43.--- RCW (the new chapter created in section 7 of this act).
- 13 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 7.** Sections 1 through 5 of this act
- 14 constitute a new chapter in Title 43 RCW.
