- WHEREAS, Dr. Reid has served with distinction as superintendent of the Northshore School District since July 2016; and
- WHEREAS, Dr. Reid previously served as a high school principal and deputy superintendent in the Port Angeles School District, and superintendent of the South Kitsap School District; and

- WHEREAS, In 2005, Dr. Reid was appointed by Governor Gregoire to the Washington Learns Task Force to contribute to the development of a world-class student-focused education system in Washington state; and
- WHEREAS, Dr. Reid has been committed to serving the next generation of educators by serving as a leadership facilitator for

- the University of Washington's Center for Education Leadership and the Harvard Institute for School Leadership; and

- 9 Dr. Reid has been a tireless advocate 10 educational equity, leading the implementation of one of the 11 most comprehensive equity policies in Washington state, creating 12 a caring and welcoming learning environment for each student and 13 family, redesigning programs and removing barriers to increase 14 representation and outcomes for every student in Northshore 15 race, ethnicity, regardless of their gender, 16 socioeconomic status, gender identity, sexual orientation, 17 religion;
