- 4 (1) A person is quilty of assault in the third degree if he or
- 5 she, under circumstances not amounting to assault in the first or
- 6 second degree:
- 7 (a) With intent to prevent or resist the execution of any lawful
- 8 process or mandate of any court officer or the lawful apprehension
- 9 or detention of himself, herself, or another person, assaults
- 10 another; or
- 11 (b) Assaults a person employed as a transit operator or driver,
- 12 the immediate supervisor of a transit operator or driver, a
- 13 mechanic, or a security officer, by a public or private transit
- 14 company or a contracted transit service provider, while that person
- 15 is performing his or her official duties at the time of the assault; or
- 16 (c) Assaults a school bus driver, the immediate supervisor of a
- 17 driver, a mechanic, or a security officer, employed by a school
- 18 district transportation service or a private company under contract
- 19 for transportation services with a school district, while the person
- 20 is performing his or her official duties at the time of the assault; or
- 21 (d) With criminal negligence, causes bodily harm to another
- 22 person by means of a weapon or other instrument or thing likely to
- 23 produce bodily harm; or
- (e) Assaults a firefighter or other employee of a fire
- 25 department, county fire marshal's office, county fire prevention
- 26 bureau, or fire protection district who was performing his or her
- 27 official duties at the time of the assault; or

- 1 (f) With criminal negligence, causes bodily harm accompanied by
- 2 substantial pain that extends for a period sufficient to cause
- 3 considerable suffering; or
- 4 (g) Assaults a law enforcement officer or other employee of a
- 5 law enforcement agency who was performing his or her official duties
- 6 at the time of the assault; or
- 7 (h) Assaults a peace officer with a projectile stun gun; or
- 8 (i) Assaults a nurse, physician, or health care provider who was
- 9 performing his or her nursing or health care duties at the time of
- 10 the assault. For purposes of this subsection: "Nurse" means a person
- 11 licensed under chapter 18.79 RCW; "physician" means a person
- 12 licensed under chapter 18.57 or 18.71 RCW; and "health care
- 13 provider" means a person certified under chapter 18.71 or 18.73 RCW
- 14 who performs emergency medical services or a person regulated under
- 15 Title 18 RCW and employed by, or contracting with, a hospital
- 16 licensed under chapter 70.41 RCW; or
- 17 (j) Assaults a judicial officer, court-related employee, county
- 18 clerk, or county clerk's employee, while that person is performing
- 19 his or her official duties at the time of the assault or as a result
- 20 of that person's employment within the judicial system. For purposes
- 21 of this subsection, "court-related employee" includes bailiffs,
- 22 court reporters, judicial assistants, court managers, court
- 23 managers' employees, and any other employee, regardless of title,
- 24 who is engaged in equivalent functions; or
- (k) Assaults a person located in a courtroom, jury room, judge's
- 26 chamber, or any waiting area or corridor immediately adjacent to a
- 27 courtroom, jury room, or judge's chamber. This section shall apply
- 28 only: (i) During the times when a courtroom, jury room, or judge's
- 29 chamber is being used for judicial purposes during court
- 30 proceedings; and (ii) if signage was posted in compliance with RCW
- 31 2.28.200 at the time of the assault; or
- 32 (1) Assaults a child welfare worker, as defined in RCW 74.14B.
- 33 <u>005</u>, who was performing his or her official duties at the time of
- 34 the assault.

1 (2) Assault in the third degree is a class C felony."

EFFECT: Elevates an assault that would otherwise be Assault in the fourth degree to Assault in the third degree when the victim of the assault is a child welfare worker acting in his or her official capacity.
