- 9 commissioner's designee may authorize expenditures from the account.
- 10 Expenditures from the account may be used only for reimbursing the
- 11 unemployment compensation fund created in RCW 50.16.010 for
- 12 socialized benefits and relief of benefits paid to individuals who
- 13 qualify for benefits under RCW 50.20.050(2)(b) (ii) and (xiii). The

- NEW SECTION. Sec. 5. The sum of \$15,000,000 is appropriated for

- On page 1, line 3 of the title, after "50.04 RCW;" strike the
- 23 remainder of the title and insert "adding a new section to chapter
- 24 50.16 RCW; creating a new section; and making an appropriation."

EFFECT: Appropriates \$15 million to a newly created unemployment insurance socialized benefits account for the purposes of reimbursing the unemployment compensation fund for benefits paid to individuals who qualify for benefits related to separation from employment due to the death, illness, or disability of a family member, inaccessible care for a child or vulnerable adult, and relocation to follow a minor child who moved outside the individual's labor market.
