- (2) Encourages public schools to provide 30 minutes of daily recess within the school day instead of making this a requirement.
- (3) Encourages public schools to hold recess outside instead of making this a requirement whenever possible.
- (4) Encourages elementary school recess to be scheduled before lunch instead of making this a requirement whenever possible.
- (5) Removes a provision strongly discouraging the withholding of recess to have a student complete academic work.
- (6) Discourages using physical activity as punishment instead of prohibiting this action.
- (7) Encourages school districts to adopt or amend their policies and procedures to incorporate a model instead of making this a requirement.
