Brief Description: Expanding access to dual credit programs.

Brief Summary of Bill

- Creates a dual credit subsidy program for eligible students from low-income households.
- Reduces per college credit fees for college in the high school students.
- Makes changes to Running Start Program provisions, for example related to funding and summer enrollment.
- Expands requirements to notify students and their parents about dual credit programs and available financial assistance.
- Creates a dual credit incentive rebate.
