- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 69.30
- 6 RCW to read as follows:
- 7 The department has authority to regulate crab with respect to
- 8 health and safety in relation to biotoxin contamination. For the
- 9 purposes of this section, crab means any commercially harvested crab.
- 10 By June 30, 2025, the state board of health may adopt rules
- 11 regulating crab harvesting, tracking, and recalls.
- 12 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** If specific funding for the purposes of
- 13 this act, referencing this act by bill or chapter number, is not
- 14 provided by June 30, 2023, in the omnibus appropriations act, this
- 15 act is null and void.
- 16 NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. This act is necessary for the immediate
- 17 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of
