- 1 AN ACT Relating to off-duty employment of fish and wildlife
- 2 officers; adding a new section to chapter 77.15 RCW; and adding a new
- 3 section to chapter 4.92 RCW.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 77.15 6 RCW to read as follows:
- Washington fish and wildlife officers may engage in private law
- 8 enforcement off-duty employment, in uniform or in plainclothes for
- 9 private benefit, subject to guidelines adopted by the chief of fish
- 10 and wildlife enforcement. These guidelines must ensure that the
- 11 integrity and professionalism of the Washington fish and wildlife
- 12 enforcement is preserved. Use of Washington fish and wildlife
- 13 officer's uniforms shall be considered de minimis use of state
- 14 property.
- 15 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 4.92 RCW
- 16 to read as follows:
- 17 (1) The state is not liable for tortious conduct by department of
- 18 fish and wildlife officers that occurs while such officers are
- 19 engaged in private law enforcement off-duty employment.
