1 AN ACT Relating to requiring the use of a turn signal to indicate  
2 that a vehicle is about to exit a circular intersection; and amending  
3 RCW 46.61.305.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 46.61.305 and 1975 c 62 s 30 are each amended to  
6 read as follows:

7 (1) No person shall turn a vehicle or move right or left upon a  
8 roadway unless and until such movement can be made with reasonable  
9 safety nor without giving an appropriate signal in the manner  
10 hereinafter provided.

11 (2) (a) A signal of intention to turn or move right or left when  
12 required shall be given continuously during not less than the last  
13 ~~((one hundred))~~ 100 feet traveled by the vehicle before turning,  
14 except as specified in (b) of this subsection.

15 (b) A signal of intention to exit a circular intersection shall  
16 be given continuously upon approaching the position to be used to  
17 exit the circular intersection.

18 (3) No person shall stop or suddenly decrease the speed of a  
19 vehicle without first giving an appropriate signal in the manner  
20 provided herein to the driver of any vehicle immediately to the rear  
21 when there is opportunity to give such signal.

1           (4) The signals provided for in RCW 46.61.310 (~~(subsection)~~) (2),  
2 shall not be flashed on one side only on a disabled vehicle, flashed  
3 as a courtesy or "do pass" signal to operators of other vehicles  
4 approaching from the rear, nor be flashed on one side only of a  
5 parked vehicle except as may be necessary for compliance with this  
6 section.
