1 AN ACT Relating to creating keep Washington evergreen special  
2 license plates; reenacting and amending RCW 46.17.220, 46.18.200, and  
3 46.68.425; adding a new section to chapter 46.04 RCW; adding a new  
4 section to chapter 46.18 RCW; creating a new section; and providing  
5 an effective date.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

7 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that Washington  
8 state is known as the evergreen state and to celebrate that the  
9 legislature intends to fund electrical charging stations while  
10 resurrecting the original white and green license plate color scheme.

11 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 46.04  
12 RCW to read as follows:

13 "Keep Washington evergreen license plate" means special license  
14 plates issued under RCW 46.18.200 that display green lettering on a  
15 white background in a style similar to the license plates issued by  
16 the department in the 1970s.

17 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 3.** A new section is added to chapter 46.18  
18 RCW to read as follows:

(1) The department shall create, design, and issue a keep Washington evergreen license plate that may be used in lieu of standard issue or personalized license plates for motor vehicles required to display one or two license plates, excluding vehicles registered under chapter 46.87 RCW, upon terms and conditions established by the department.

(2) A registered owner may apply to the department, county auditor or other agent, or subagent appointed by the director for a keep Washington evergreen license plate. The registered owner shall pay the special license plate fee required under RCW 46.17.220(13), in addition to any other fee or tax required by law.

**Sec. 4.** RCW 46.17.220 and 2022 c 239 s 1 and 2022 c 117 s 1 are each reenacted and amended to read as follows:

In addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon application for a vehicle registration in chapter 46.16A RCW, the holder of a special license plate shall pay the appropriate special license plate fee as listed in this section.

27       **Sec. 5.** RCW 46.18.200 and 2022 c 239 s 2 and 2022 c 117 s 2 are  
28 each reenacted and amended to read as follows:

29       (1) Special license plate series reviewed and approved by the  
30 department:

31       (a) May be issued in lieu of standard issue or personalized  
32 license plates for vehicles required to display one and two license  
33 plates unless otherwise specified;

34       (b) Must be issued under terms and conditions established by the  
35 department;

1 (c) Must not be issued for vehicles registered under chapter  
2 46.87 RCW; and

3 (d) Must display a symbol or artwork approved by the department.

4 (2) The department approves and shall issue the following special  
5 license plates, subject to subsection (5) of this section:

28	Wild on Washington	Symbolizes wildlife viewing in
29		Washington state.

30 (3) Applicants for initial and renewal professional firefighters  
31 and paramedics special license plates must show proof of eligibility  
32 by providing a certificate of current membership from the Washington  
33 state council of firefighters.

34 (4) Applicants for initial volunteer firefighters special license  
35 plates must (a) have been a volunteer firefighter for at least  
36 ((ten)) 10 years or be a volunteer firefighter for one or more years  
37 and (b) have documentation of service from the district of the  
38 appropriate fire service. If the volunteer firefighter leaves



1 firefighting service before (~~ten~~) 10 years of service have been  
2 completed, the volunteer firefighter shall surrender the license  
3 plates to the department on the registration renewal date. If the  
4 volunteer firefighter stays in service for at least (~~ten~~) 10 years  
5 and then leaves, the license plate may be retained by the former  
6 volunteer firefighter and as long as the license plate is retained  
7 for use the person will continue to pay the future registration  
8 renewals. A qualifying volunteer firefighter may have no more than  
9 one set of license plates per vehicle, and a maximum of two sets per  
10 applicant, for their personal vehicles. If the volunteer firefighter  
11 is convicted of a violation of RCW 46.61.502 or a felony, the license  
12 plates must be surrendered upon conviction.

13 (5) The department shall not issue the Seattle NHL hockey special  
14 license plate until the department receives signature sheets  
15 satisfying the requirements identified in RCW 46.18.110(2)(f).

16 **Sec. 6.** RCW 46.68.425 and 2016 c 31 s 3 and 2016 c 30 s 4 are  
17 each reenacted and amended to read as follows:

18 (1) The department shall:

19 (a) Collect special license plate fees established under RCW  
20 46.17.220;

21 (b) Deduct an amount not to exceed (~~twelve dollars~~) \$12 for  
22 initial issue and (~~two dollars~~) \$2 for renewal issue for  
23 administration and collection expenses incurred by it; and

24 (c) Remit the remaining proceeds to the custody of the state  
25 treasurer with a proper identifying detailed report.

26 (2) The state treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor  
27 vehicle fund until the department determines that the state has been  
28 reimbursed for the cost of implementing the special license plate.  
29 Upon determination by the department that the state has been  
30 reimbursed, the state treasurer shall credit the remaining special  
31 license plate fees to the following accounts by special license plate  
32 type:
