- 1 AN ACT Relating to requiring state agencies to clearly identify
- 2 programs and services which accept applicants with deferred action
- 3 for childhood arrival status; adding a new section to chapter 43.17
- 4 RCW; and creating a new section.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 6 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 43.17
- 7 RCW to read as follows:
- 8 Each state agency must clearly identify on the agency's website
- 9 all programs or services administered by the agency for which
- 10 applicants are not ineligible solely due to deferred action for
- 11 childhood arrival status.
- 12 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** Nothing in this act creates a requirement
- 13 for any entity to update or revise existing materials, documents, or
- 14 publications.
