- AN ACT Relating to requiring local airport operators to provide sustainable aviation fuel for use in private jets; adding a new section to chapter 14.08 RCW; adding a new section to chapter 19.94
- 4 RCW; and creating a new section.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 6 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. The legislature finds that sustainable 7 aviation fuels represent a significant opportunity to 8 emissions in the aviation sector. By requiring a growing percentage 9 of fuel usage by private jets to be sustainable aviation fuel, the 10 state will improve the health and quality of life for Washingtonians 11 and stimulate the growth of the sustainable aviation fuel industry in 12 Washington. The legislature intends to encourage and promote the 13 development, availability, and use of sustainable aviation fuels.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 14.08 15 RCW to read as follows:
- 16 (1) By July 1, 2028, airport operators, when providing aviation 17 fuel for use in private aircraft utilizing jet fuel and operating 18 under federal aviation regulation part 91, owned by individuals or 19 businesses, must provide fuel blends with a minimum of 10 percent 20 sustainable aviation fuel.

- 1 (2) The department of transportation aviation division may 2 provide technical assistance to airport operators as necessary for 3 implementation of this section including, but not limited to: 4 Communications, customer advisories, or technical implementation 5 assistance.
- 6 (3) The governor, by executive order, may suspend all or portions 7 of the minimum sustainable aviation fuel content requirements in this 8 section based on a determination that such requirements are 9 temporarily, technically, or economically infeasible, or pose a 10 significant risk to public safety.
- 11 (4) "Sustainable aviation fuel" means alternative jet fuel, as defined in RCW 70A.535.010.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. A new section is added to chapter 19.94 RCW to read as follows:
- 15 (1) By November 1, 2027, the department must adopt rules for enforcing and carrying out the purposes of section 2 of this act.
- 17 (2) By December 1, 2027, the director must notify the governor 18 and the transportation committees of the legislature of the rules 19 adopted in subsection (1) of this section.
