1 AN ACT Relating to Testing for session; and amending RCW 2 1.04.010, 1.04.020, and 1.04.030.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 Sec. 1. RCW 1.04.010 and 1951 c 5 s 2 are each amended to read 5 as follows:

6 The ninety-one titles with chapters and sections designated as 7 the "Revised Code of Washington" and attested by the secretary of the senate and the chief clerk of the house of representatives of the 8 legislature of the state of Washington, are hereby enacted and 9 10 designated as the "Revised Code of Washington." Said code is intended 11 embrace in a revised, consolidated, and codified form and to 12 arrangement all the laws of the state of a general and permanent 13 nature. Here is new Text.

14 Sec. 2. RCW 1.04.020 and 1951 c 5 s 6 are each amended to read 15 as follows:

16 The contents of the Revised Code of Washington, after striking 17 therefrom sections repealed or superseded by laws of the state of 18 Washington enacted since January 1, 1949, as the revised code is 19 supplemented or modified in the 1950 supplement, shall establish the 20 laws of this state of a general and permanent nature in effect on

January 1, 1951; except, that nothing herein shall be construed as 1 changing the meaning of any such laws and, as a rule of construction, 2 in case of any omissions or any inconsistency between any of the 3 provisions of the revised code as so supplemented or modified and the 4 laws existing immediately preceding this enactment, the previously 5 6 existing laws shall control. Any section of the Revised Code of 7 Washington (as supplemented or modified by the 1950 supplement) expressly amended by the legislature, including the entire context 8 9 set out, shall, as so amended, constitute the law and the ultimate declaration of legislative intent. 10

11 Sec. 3. RCW 1.04.030 and 1950 ex.s. c 16 s 3 are each amended to 12 read as follows:

All laws of a general and permanent nature enacted after January 14 1, 1949, shall, from time to time, be incorporated into and become a 15 part of said code.
