- NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 1.04 RCW to read as follows:
 - App Portfolios and LEG-TECH Teams have roadmaps, e.g., Lawmaking, Rostrum, Admin Apps, Public Web portfolios and TSG, CSG, MSG have dedicated roadmaps. Each "Bar" or "Container" on the roadmap represents a project with estimated start and end dates. A "Container" can be a parent to many bars for tracking milestones or other increments of a project. "Containers" can be collapsed for ease of viewing the roadmap. "Bars" can also be placed directly on a roadmap Lanes are used to represent subgroups or application suites The Legend is used for project status. "Tags" are used to represent cross-team dependencies. Portfolio or Team roadmaps will roll into higher-level views for Leadership and cross-team planning. Wherever possible, we'll start as simple as possible, add things, and increase complexity only where it is worth it. Any roadmap expected to be rolled up and shared across teams must follow the agreed-upon standards. Roadmaps meant for internal use only can break from
