 medications administered or provided during the delivery of health
 care services or pursuant to a valid prescription; or
- 16 <u>(b) Methamphetamine</u> or ephedrine, pseudoephedrine, or anhydrous 17 ammonia, including their salts, isomers, and salts of isomers, that 18 are being used in the manufacture of methamphetamine, including its 19 salts, isomers, and salts of isomers.
- 20 <u>(2) The department of children, youth, and families and any</u> 21 <u>employees, interns, volunteers, or contractors of the department</u>

- 1 acting in the scope of their role are exempt from any criminal
- 2 <u>liability within this section.</u>
- 3 (3) Endangerment with a controlled substance is a class B felony.
