- AN ACT Relating to protecting the health care of workers 1
- 2 exercising their right to participate in a labor dispute; adding a
- 3 new section to chapter 43.71 RCW; and creating a new section.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 43.71
- 6 RCW to read as follows:
- 7 (1) By January 1, 2025, the exchange must establish a worker
- health plan access program to help Washingtonians who lose health 8
- care coverage provided by their employer or a joint labor management 9
- 10 trust as a result of an active strike, lockout, or other labor
- 11 dispute.
- 12 (2) Subject to the availability of funding, the exchange must
- 13 provide enrollment assistance to help maintain coverage for
- 14 individuals and their dependents who:
- 15 (a) Provide a self-attestation regarding loss of minimum
- 16 essential health care coverage from an employer or joint labor
- 17 management trust fund as a result of an active strike, lockout, or
- 18 other labor dispute; and
- 19 (b) Are eligible for coverage offered through the exchange.
- 20 (3) The exchange may request, and an applicable employer, labor
- 21 organization, or other appropriate representative, must provide,

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- 1 information to determine the status of a strike, lockout, or labor
- 2 dispute, its impact to coverage, and any other information determined
- 3 by the exchange as necessary to conduct outreach and determine
- 4 eligibility for federal and state subsidies offered through the
- 5 exchange.
- 6 (4) The exchange must establish a process for providing outreach
- 7 and enrollment assistance, and may establish additional procedural
- 8 requirements to administer the program established in subsection (1)
- 9 of this section.
- 10 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** This act may be known and cited as the
- 11 worker health care protection act.

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
