1 WHEREAS, Engrossed Second Substitute Senate Bill No. 5536
2 introduced at the 2023 regular session of the sixty-eighth
3 Legislature addresses important public policy matters for
4 consideration at the 2023 first special session of the sixty-eighth
5 Legislature; and

6 WHEREAS, The public interest requires that the business of the
7 2023 first special session of the sixty-eighth Legislature be
8 considered and acted upon as efficiently and expeditiously as
9 possible;

10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, By Senate of the state of
11 Washington, the House of Representatives concurring, That Engrossed
12 Second Substitute Senate Bill No. 5536 introduced at the 2023 regular
13 session of the sixty-eighth Legislature is reintroduced in the house
14 in which it originated and shall retain the same number and be given
15 the highest legislative status that it attained in the original house
16 as shown by the official House and Senate dockets upon the
17 adjournment SINE DIE of the regular session.
