- AN ACT Relating to job postings requiring driver's licenses; and
- 2 adding a new section to chapter 49.60 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- MEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 49.60 RCW to read as follows:
- 6 (1) It is an unfair practice for any employer to include a 7 statement in a job advertisement, posting, application, or other 8 material that an applicant must have a valid driver's license, unless 9 both of the following conditions are met:
- 10 (a) The employer reasonably expects driving to be one of the 11 essential job functions for the position; and
- 12 (b) The employer reasonably believes that satisfying the 13 essential job function using an alternative form of transportation 14 would not be comparable in travel time or cost to the employer.
- 15 (2) For purposes of this section, "alternative form of transportation" includes, but is not limited to, all of the following:
- 18 (a) Using a ride hailing service;
- 19 (b) Using a taxi;
- 20 (c) Carpooling;
- 21 (d) Bicycling;
