1 AN ACT Relating to early registration at institutions of higher  
2 education for students with dependents; adding a new section to  
3 chapter 28B.10 RCW; and creating a new section.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that students who  
6 have dependents should have priority registration given their  
7 demanding schedules and caregiving responsibilities. Giving students  
8 with dependents early registration is just one way the legislature  
9 can support families and students.

10 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 28B.10  
11 RCW to read as follows:

12 (1) Beginning in the 2025-26 academic year, institutions of  
13 higher education that offer an early course registration period for  
14 any segment of the student population must have a process in place to  
15 offer students who have dependents early course registration as  
16 follows:

17 (a) New students who have dependents and who have completed all  
18 of their admission processes must be offered an early course  
19 registration period; and

1           (b) Continuing and returning former students who have dependents  
2 and who have met current enrollment requirements must be offered  
3 early course registration among continuing students with the same  
4 level of class standing or credit as determined by the attending  
5 institution and according to institutional policies.

6           (2) For purposes of this section, "dependents" are: Children 18  
7 years of age or younger who are under the registering student's care;  
8 and persons who, because of physical or mental disability or because  
9 of extreme advanced age, is dependent upon the registering student to  
10 provide the basic necessities of life.
