1 AN ACT Relating to facilitating the prompt replacement of
2 defective continuous glucose monitoring equipment; and adding a new
3 section to chapter 18.64 RCW.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 18.64
6 RCW to read as follows:

7 (1) A pharmacy in a physical location that dispenses continuous
8 glucose monitoring equipment shall maintain a sufficient supply of
9 monitoring sensors to enable the pharmacy to provide a same-day
10 replacement sensor to a patient who experiences an equipment
11 malfunction or an emergency that necessitates an additional sensor to
12 be dispensed.

13 (2) A mail-order pharmacy that dispenses continuous glucose
14 monitoring equipment shall maintain a sufficient supply of monitoring
15 sensors to enable the pharmacy to promptly provide a replacement
16 sensor to a patient who experiences an equipment malfunction or an
17 emergency that necessitates an additional sensor to be dispensed. For
18 purposes of this subsection, "promptly" means mailing a replacement
19 sensor to the patient no later than the next business day or, if

1 mailing the replacement by the next business day is not possible, as
2 soon as practicable.

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
