3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 1.04.010 and 1951 c 5 s 2 are each amended to read
5 as follows:

6 The TESTING A SUB ninety-one titles with chapters and sections
7 designated as the "Revised Code of Washington" and attested by the
8 secretary of the senate and the chief clerk of the house of
9 representatives of the legislature of the state of Washington, are
10 hereby enacted and designated as the "Revised Code of Washington."
11 Said code is intended to embrace in a revised, consolidated, and
12 codified form and arrangement all the laws of the state of a general
13 and permanent nature.

14 **Sec. 2.** RCW 1.04.010 and 1951 c 5 s 2 are each amended to read
15 as follows:

16 The ninety-one titles with chapters and sections designated as
17 the "Revised Code of Washington" and attested by the secretary of the
18 senate and the chief clerk of the house of representatives of the
19 legislature of the state of Washington, are hereby enacted and
20 designated as the "Revised Code of Washington." Said code is intended
