- 1 AN ACT Relating to maintaining the privacy of party selections
- 2 during presidential primaries; adding a new section to chapter 29A.56
- 3 RCW; and creating a new section.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that every
- 6 presidential primary election, voters contact legislators, auditors,
- 7 and other government officials with concerns about the visibility of
- 8 their party preference selections on the outside of presidential
- 9 primary ballot envelopes. Often, the concern is that just by seeing
- the party preference, an outside observer would know that voter's
- 11 presidential candidate vote. The legislature further finds that in
- 12 order to protect the secrecy of the ballot, a party preference
- 13 selection must be kept as secret as any other part of the ballot.
- 14 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 29A.56
- 15 RCW to read as follows:
- 16 Where a voter is required to make a political party declaration
- 17 on a ballot or ballot envelope:
- 18 (1) That declaration must be placed such that the ballot envelope
- 19 must be opened in order for anyone to see the declaration; and

1 (2) The ballot envelope must include a prominently placed 2 reminder to the voter that a political party declaration is required 3 for the ballot to be counted.
