4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 71A.10.100 and 2022 c 247 s 1 are each amended to
6 read as follows:

7 ~~((1))~~ The department shall hire two permanent, full-time
8 employees to regularly review and maintain the no-paid services
9 caseload. This includes, but is not limited to, updating the no-paid
10 services caseload to accurately reflect a current head count of
11 eligible individuals and identifying the number of individuals
12 contacted who are currently interested in receiving a paid service
13 from the developmental disabilities administration and if the
14 individual would like services now or within the next year. Beginning
15 December 1, 2022, the department shall annually report this
16 information to the governor and the appropriate committees of the
17 legislature.

18 ~~((2) A client on the no-paid services caseload shall receive~~
19 ~~case resource management services. The case resource manager's duties~~
20 ~~include: (a) Contacting and responding to the client to discuss the~~
