RCW 70A.55.010 Findings—Intent. The legislature finds that investments in diesel engine idling reduction projects costeffectively improve public health by reducing harmful diesel emissions. The legislature further finds that these investments also result in long-term savings in fuel and maintenance costs. It is therefore the intent of the legislature to establish a stable, wholly self-sustaining account for the department of ecology to use for investments in diesel idle reduction projects.
