WAC 132X-40-010 Environmental protection rule. It shall be the rule of South Puget Sound Community College District 24 that capital projects proposed and developed by the college shall comply with the provisions of chapter 43.21C RCW, the State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA); chapter 197-11 WAC, SEPA rules; and WAC 131-24-030, SEPA implementation rules of the state board for community college education.
