WAC 208-630-290 How much are the fees for various license applications, and when does a licensee pay them? (1) The director shall collect a fee of sixty-nine dollars per employee hour expended for services, plus actual expenses, for review, investigation and processing of:

- (a) New license applications;
- (b) Small loan endorsement applications;
- (c) Additional locations;
- (d) Change of control;
- (e) Relocation of office;
- (f) Voluntary or involuntary liquidation of licensee.(2) The director may require a lump sum payment in advance to cover the anticipated cost of review and investigation of the activities described in this section.
