WAC 208-630-717 Must a licensee provide notice to consumers if its data is compromised? Maybe. If the licensee's data is compromised the licensee may be subject to chapter 19.255 RCW and may have to pro-vide notices to consumers whose information was acquired. Under certain circumstances notice of the breach may also be required by the attorney general's office.
